# ALTERNATIVE ENERGY: ICELAND AND SCANDINAVIA

## **Program Description:**

Walk on black beaches and swim in hot springs near the Arctic Circle. See geysers, waterfalls, fjords and glaciers. Explore four of Europe's most fascinating capital cities, Reykjavik, Iceland; Oslo, Norway; Stockholm, Sweden; and Copenhagen, Denmark. This is the backdrop to our curriculum focused on renewable energy including geothermal, hydroelectric and wind power. Students will learn how these countries produce almost all of their electricity in ways that help combat problems with climate change, population growth and fossil fuel depletion. Tours of each country will allow students to see the impact of alternative energy sources within the context of each culture.
