Nestled in the heart of Rome, the College of Architecture, Art and Design (CAAD) Summer Program is the perfect study abroad opportunity for Art, Architecture, Interior Design & Building Construction Science majors. The Rome Center studios are housed in the 14th C. Palazzo Taverna, at the epicenter of ancient, classical and modern creative heritage.
