Program Description:

Earn 12 hours of FLS credit by studying this summer in Alcalá de Henares, Spain! You will take classes from the Spanish faculty at Alcalaingua and go on cultural and historical excursions to Madrid and Segovia, all with time for travel and cultural immersion.

Alcalá de Henares is a city of roughly 200,000 people, located within easy travel distance of nearby Madrid, and with very good connections to transportation to all parts of Spain. This program is suitable for undergraduate students who have completed Spanish III (or equivalent), including students in languages, International Business and students from throughout MSU wishing to complete a Spanish minor.

12 credits of Spanish Language and Culture Courses

Eligibility/Prerequisites:

Spanish III is a required pre-requisite. Students need to have at least a 2.5 GPA in order to participate in this program.
