



Spanish Language Immersion (June & July) Alcalá, Spain

Program Description:

Earn 12 hours of 2000- or 3000-level Spanish credits in classes taught by native speakers, housing with Spanish host family, and city tours to Madrid and Segovia, through our program located in Alcalá de Henares, Spain. Alcalá is a medium-sized city of 200,000 inhabitants within easy travel distance to Madrid. Along with taking language and culture classes, students will have abundant opportunities for tourism and cultural immersion, and by staying with host families, should be able to markedly improve their Spanish communication skills. Cultural activities will include trips to museums, cultural discussions and observations (20 hours), as well as trips to neighboring cities.

Program Dates:

June 1—August 2, 2017

Course:

12 Credits of Spanish Language Courses and Cultural Activities at Alcalingua in June and July (160 hours in class).

Requirements:

Students need to have completed FLS 2133 or equivalent and have at least a 2.5 GPA in order to participate in this program. This program is suitable for undergraduate students of Foreign Languages, International Business, students with double majors or minors with a concentration in Spanish, and any student interested in improving their Spanish language skills. Exceptions to these requirements are made with prior consultation and approval of the Faculty Director.
