## Nutrition and Health Through the Ages (Czech Republic)

### Program Description:

This study abroad was developed for undergraduate and graduate students interested in global nutrition, health and Eastern European history. The country visited on this trip will be Czech Republic and the cities visited will be Prague, Terezin, and Karlovy Vary. You will visit a Prague castle dating back to the 9th century, a former concentration camp to learn about the horrors of the 2nd World War, visit Charles University founded in 1348, learn about the benefits of mineral water therapy at the Carlsbad spa founded in 1370, tour the New Town Brewery to learn about the ancient art of making beer, visit Botanicus garden complex to learn about medicinal and culinary herbs and visit the museum of communism. There will be plenty of time to explore the most beautiful city in the world on your own as well.

### Requirements:

All students with at least a 2.5 GPA and sophomore standing are welcome to participate in this program. This course satisfies an elective requirement.
