



Engineering Economy in France + Barcelona + London

Program Description:

The program offers an opportunity to study in France with other MSU students while sharing outside of the classroom activities and weekend trips with French students. You will learn how to evaluate alternative engineering proposals, tour French engineering companies (including Airbus), and visit famous European landmarks and sights. The program will be mostly hosted in Albi and Toulouse (Southern France). At the end of the program the group will visit Barcelona (Spain), Paris (France), and London (UK). A long weekend can be used for personal travel.

Course:

IE 3913: Engineering Economy (3 credit hours)

Requirements:

Students need to have completed MA 1713: Calculus I in order to participate in this course. The course is open to students of all majors and all standings with at least a 2.5 GPA. This course fulfills a major requirement for all Mechanical, Civil, Industrial, Chemical, Petroleum majors and an engineering elective for all other engineering majors.
