Course:

EM 2413: Engineering Mechanics I: Statics (3 credit hours)

Requirements:

Students need to have completed both MA 1723 and PH 2213 with a C or better and have at least a 2.5 GPA in order to participate in this program. This is a required course for all engineering majors except CSE and ECE.
