



Archaeological Travel and Participation in Israel

Program Description:

Come join us in the excavation of a site in modern Israel and see the country from the Dead Sea to the Mediterranean Coast, from the ancient Canaanite cities of the north to the Judahite fortresses of the Negev Desert in the South. No previous archaeological experience is necessary and all participants will receive first-hand training in excavation and survey techniques and introduction to field laboratory processing and analysis of artifacts. Among the many places visited are Caesarea, Megiddo (biblical Armageddon), sites around the Sea of Galilee, Jerusalem, Masada, Qumran, and Beer Sheva.
