



Italian Language and Culture in Rome and Catania, Italy

Program Description:

The first part of the program will focus on the opportunity for the students to visit Rome and in particular Montecitorio, the Italian Parliament, led by the program Director and an Italian House Representative. This tour will retrace the steps of Italian history through one of the places dedicated to the representation of the Italian people - The Camera dei Deputati. The House Representative will showcase the importance of and cooperating with other cultures and understanding historical evolution and, in regards to Italy, admiring the art that characterizes it as a time of spiritual confrontation to grasp the essence and understand the profound humanity that it underlines. After sightseeing in Rome, the group will travel to Catania for the language portion of the program.

Course:

Italian language transfer credit (3 or 6 credit hours)

Requirements:

All students who have completed at least one semester of Italian and have at least a 2.5 GPA are welcome.
