



Poultry Science in New Zealand

Program Description:

This program will introduce students to poultry production practices in New Zealand, from broilers to layers to breeders; it will include processing plants and feed mills. In addition, students will experience classes at two universities and interact with students there. A significant experience will be a Maori cultural event and overnight. Recreational activities include whale and seal watching, ziplines, thermal mud pools, Hobbiton, bird sanctuary, bird recovery center, and NZ forests.
