## Global Nutrition: Focus On Thailand

### Program Description:

This study abroad program was developed for undergraduate and graduate students from Food Science, Nutrition and Health Promotion majors or any other students interested in nutrition and health. It is incorporated in a special topic course focused on Global Nutrition. The chosen country is Thailand, and the city visited on this trip will be Bangkok. Students will have the opportunity to participate in a variety of activities related to nutrition including visiting the Institute of Nutrition at Mahidol University, explore Thai street food and the floating market, attend Thai cooking class, learn about Thai traditional and alternative medicine and visit the governmental and private hospital kitchens. In addition, students will participate in various activities to learn about the Thai culture including visit to the Ancient City, attend the crocodile and elephant show, and a visit to the Royal Grand Palace to name just a few. There will be plenty of time for shopping and traditional Thai massage as well. This study abroad program will be filled with learning and fun!
